

- June 27 - The Horsman picnic today.
- July 6 - Went to Lecky's - 4 shoes set on horses $162\frac{1}{2}^4$
 (This was more expensive than Dickson's; when I was small Uncle Sandy was still going to John Lecky somewhere north-east of Rebecca.)
- July 25 - Angus Sutherland's funeral.
- Aug. 18 - Mrs. Cowan's funeral. (James Cowan's wife)
- Aug. 25 - Mr. McDonald preached in the school house. (Old Johnnie McKay-Bruce's grandfather and Uncle Sandy arranged this preaching at S. S. 8, E. Missouri)
- 1873 - Jan. 16 - Very slippery. Geo. Snetsinger and I couldn't go out to collect for the church
- Jan. 25 - All down the 12th turned out to cut snow banks to Governor's Road.
- Jan. 26 - Everybody got to church.
- 1874 - Feb. 19 - Chas. Cowan married. (to Marion Heir sister of Alex. on Governor's Road.)
- Mar. 3 - Bought haystack from John McKay for \$35.50.
- Mar. 4 - Sandy Heir and Jane McKay married - very muddy.
- Mar. 22 - Mrs. John Adams died.
- Apr. 1. - Took home haystack from John McKay.
- Apr. 20 - Took seat rents to Mr. Heir - \$11.25
- Aug. 10 - Hauled in peas all afternoon and went out at night to Barnum's show.
- Nov. 10 - Mr. Cameron inducted at Thamesford; seven ministers there; beautiful day.
- 1875 - Jan. 17 - Sunday - still cold - at church - large meeting at our school house in afternoon.
- Mar. 8. - At Thamesford - contract for church
- Mar. 10 - hauling sand for church.
