CURRIED CHICKEN

1/2 tsp. oregano
3/4 tsp. parsley flakes
1 pinch red pepper

Mix all above with a little water and add to the chicken.

Then add 3 sliced onions
1/4 cup ketchup
salt
pepper

Add enough water to nearly cover chicken. Cover and cook on low heat for one hour.

Serve with rice.
