Recipe of The Week

RHUBARB BISQUE

DOUGHNUTS

1 cup sugar
2 tablespoons cooking oil
2 eggs
1/2 teaspoon salt
3 cups flour
4 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
3/4 cup buttermilk
1/2 teaspoon baking soda

Cream the sugar and cooking oil together. Drop in the eggs, one at a time, beating after each one is added.

Sift the dry ingredients together and add alternately with the buttermilk. Chill for an hour. Roll out on floured board and fry at 350 deg. - 360 deg.

Try rolling a whole pitted date into the middle of balls of this dough before frying. Watch the faces light up when folks bite into them.
