CRAZY QUILT SALAD (Repeated by Request)

Dressing:

1/4 cup white vinegar	1 tsp. dry mustard
1/2 cup salad oil	
1/4 tsp. ground pepper	1/2 tsp. salt
1 tsp. thyme	a pinch of garlic salt

1 15 oz.	tin Cut Green Beans
1 15 oz.	tin Cut Wax Beans
1 14 oz.	tin Red Kidney Beans
1 15 oz.	Lima Beans
1 cup	celery
1/2 cup	onion rings or chunks
1/4 cup	green pepper
sprinkle with salt, Accent and mix.	

Pour dressing over mix in a container with a tight seal and let stand for one day in refrigerator before serving.
