Last week we told you about the modest, little home in the country that you cannot have -- at least, not in East Missouri Township, you can't.

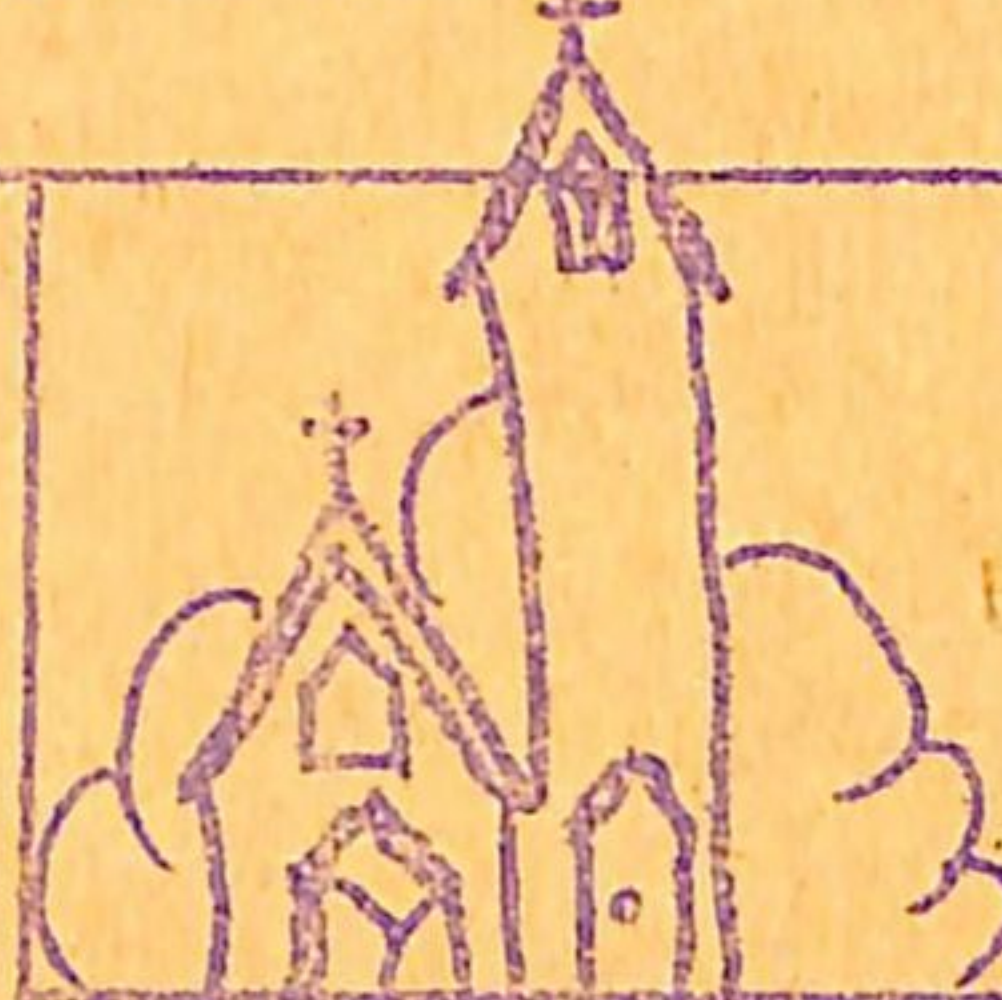
This week we will tell you what you CAN have.

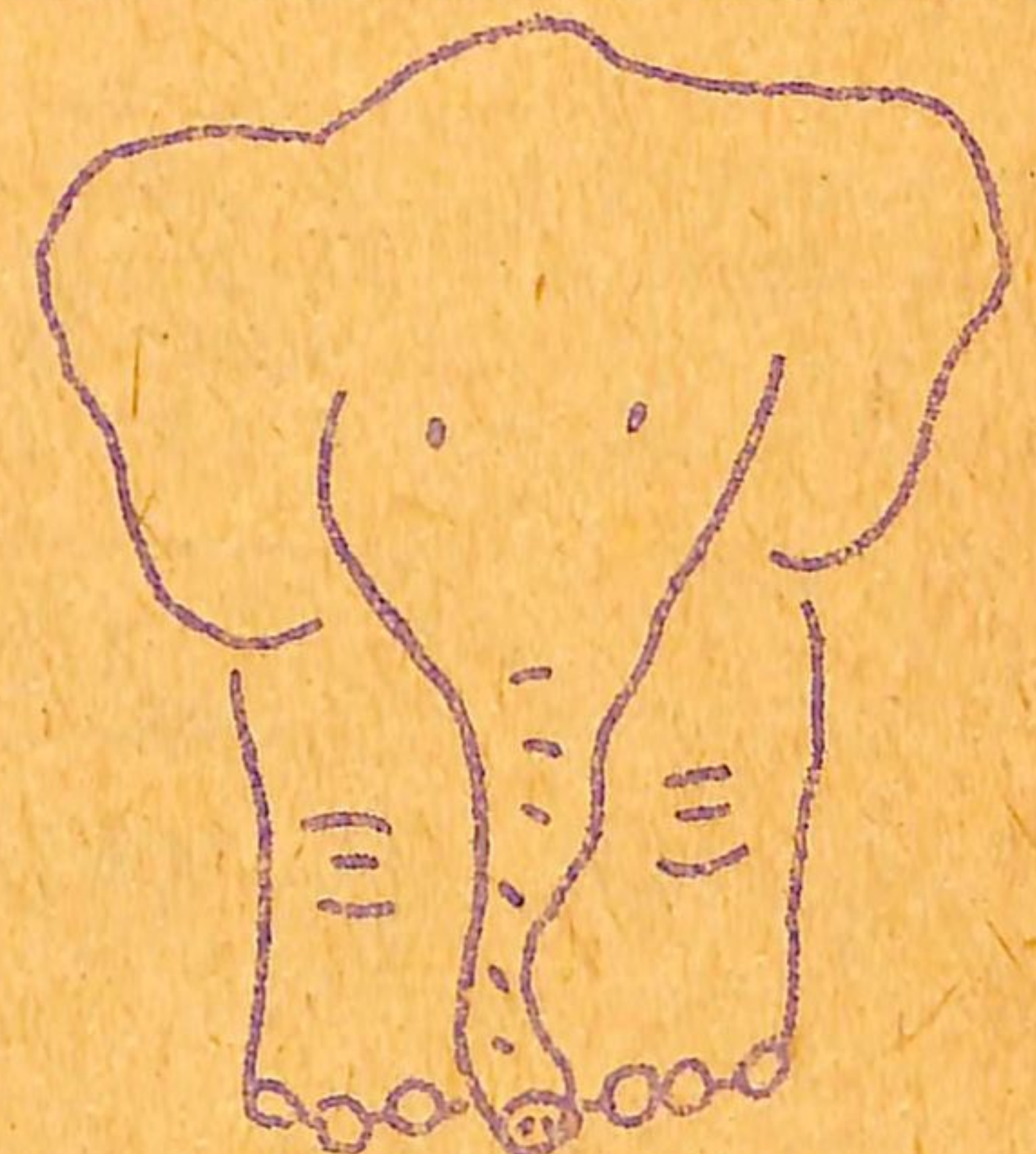
Poetry Corner
