Mayoralty races likely in Oxford

WOODSTOCK — Mayoralty contests appear likely in all eight, municipalities slated to become part of the political scene in restructured Oxford County Jan. 1.

At east two candidates were nominated for the mayor's chair in each of the municipalities, including incumbent mayors in Woodstock, Ingersoll and Tillsonburg.

Nominations closed Monday at 5 p.m. and candidates have until 5 p.m. today to change their minds and withdraw, or in some cases select which positions they will seek. Some have been nominated for more than one job. Election day is Oct. 7.

Under the restructuring, Woodstock and Ingersoll will rejoin the county council system, Woodstock sending six members and Ingersoll, two. Tillsonburg, the other urban municipaity, also will sent two representatives to county council.

The 15 rural municipalities are merging into five municipalities (each with two county councillors) including:

Blandford — Blenheim Township, consisting of the existing Blandford and Blenheim townships;

Township of East Zorra-Tavistock, consisting of existing East Zorra Township and

A northwest township yet to be named consisting of existing North Oxford Township, West Zorra Township, East Nissouri Township, Embro and the unincorporated village of Thamesford (on Oct. 7 residents will be selecting a name from a list of North Nizorra, Thames or Zorra for their new name);

Township of Norwich including the existing East Oxford Township, North Norwich Township, Village of Norwich and South

Norwich Township.

In Woodstock, Mayor Leslie Cook and Ald. William Hewson have been nominated for the head of the municipal council and with it a seat on county council.

Acting mayor J. Seldon Wilkinson and Coun. William Bennett have filed nomination

papers for mayor in Tillsonburg.

Mayor Gordon Henry and Coun. Douglas Harris of Ingersoll have both filed nomination papers for mayor, however Coun. Harris also filed papers for the councillor-atlarge position including county council service) and also a council position.

Warden Perry Sibbick, reeve of Blenheim Township and former Blandford Township councillor Ed Meadows have filed papers for the mayor's position in Blandford-Blenheim.

A former Oxford warden, Reeve William Ducklow of Tavistock and Coun. Harold Vogt, also of Tavistock, have been nominated for mayor for East Zorra-Tavistock.

Deputy Reeve Mac Robson, East Nissouri Township; Reeve Robert Matheson, West Zorra Township and Reeve Hartwell Baigent, North Oxford Township, have been nominated for mayor in the unnamed community.

Reeve Darwen Scott of North Norwich Township; Coun. Lavern Irving, Norwich and Coun. Leslie Dickson, North Norwich Township, a former Oxford warden, have filed nomination papers for Mayor in the Township of Norwich. Coun. Dickson also has filed papers for the position of councillor-at-large with three others.

In the Township of South-West Oxford, Reeves John Nadalin of Beachville and George Jakeman of West Oxford Township

have been nominated.
