

A meeting was held at the home of Mrs. Frank Seaton's Feb 11, 1911 with Miss Gilholme of Bright to organize a Women's Institute.

Mrs. Frank Seaton was put in for President and ten members joined. Carried on the meetings same as we do today. Had from 20 to 30 attend.

In 1915, it was turned into a Red Cross Society, met twice a month to sew and pack boxes for the boys. Had 2 Knitting contests and knit 338 pairs socks.

In 1917 had a display of Red Cross supplies at Lakeside Fair and got first prize.

Had reception in Hall and social evening for returned boys in Feb. 1918, which was enjoyed by all.

Had a supper at Dabrymples Pavilion and presented (22) twenty two boys with gold chains, valued at eight (\$18) a piece.
