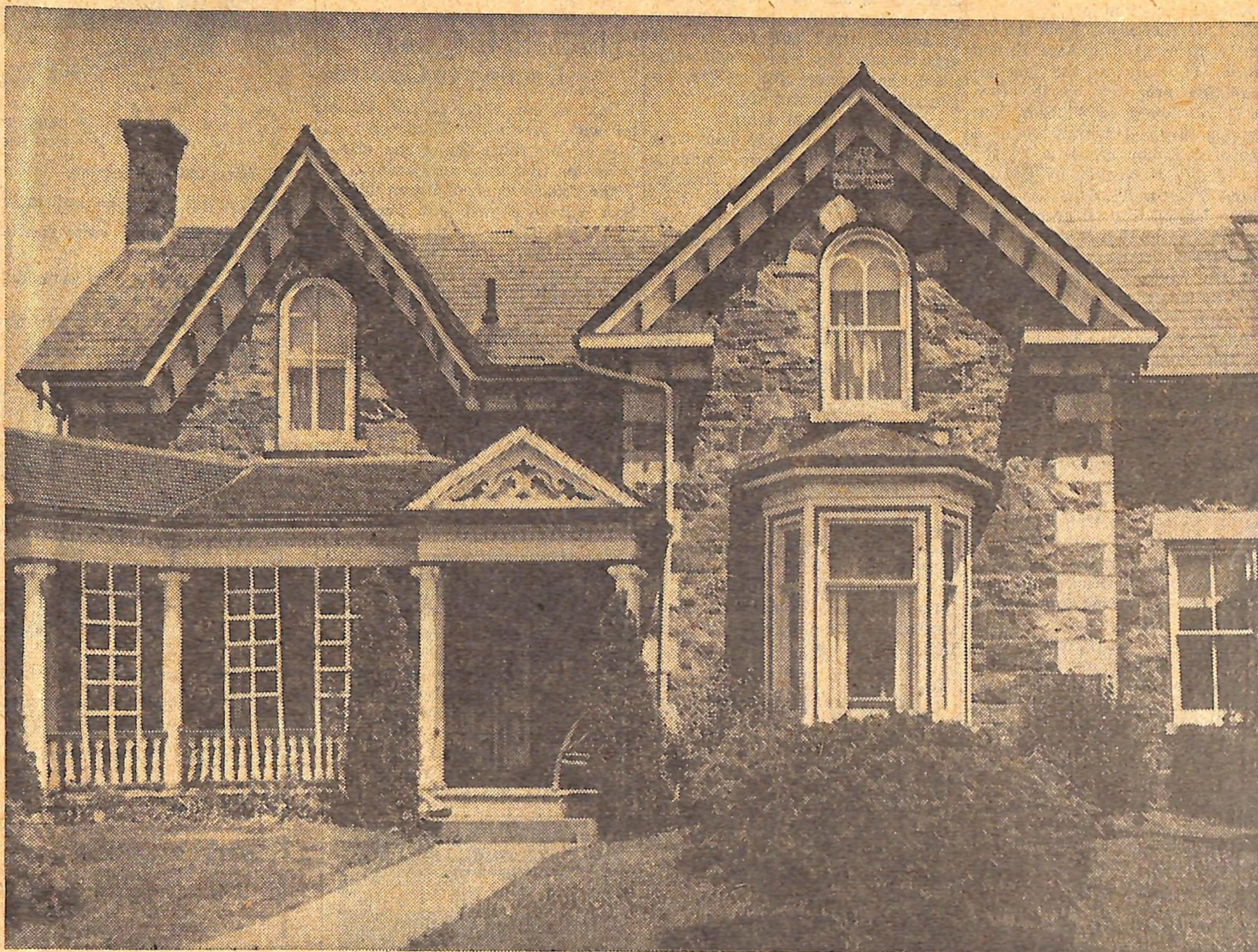


## 80-Year-Old House Tribute to Nissouri Pioneers



This fine stone residence still stands in the Lakeside district of East Nissouri Township, 80 years after it was built by Francis German and John Seaton. German was the son and Seaton the son-in-law of James German, one of the district's earliest settlers, who came to East Nissouri in the early 1800's.
