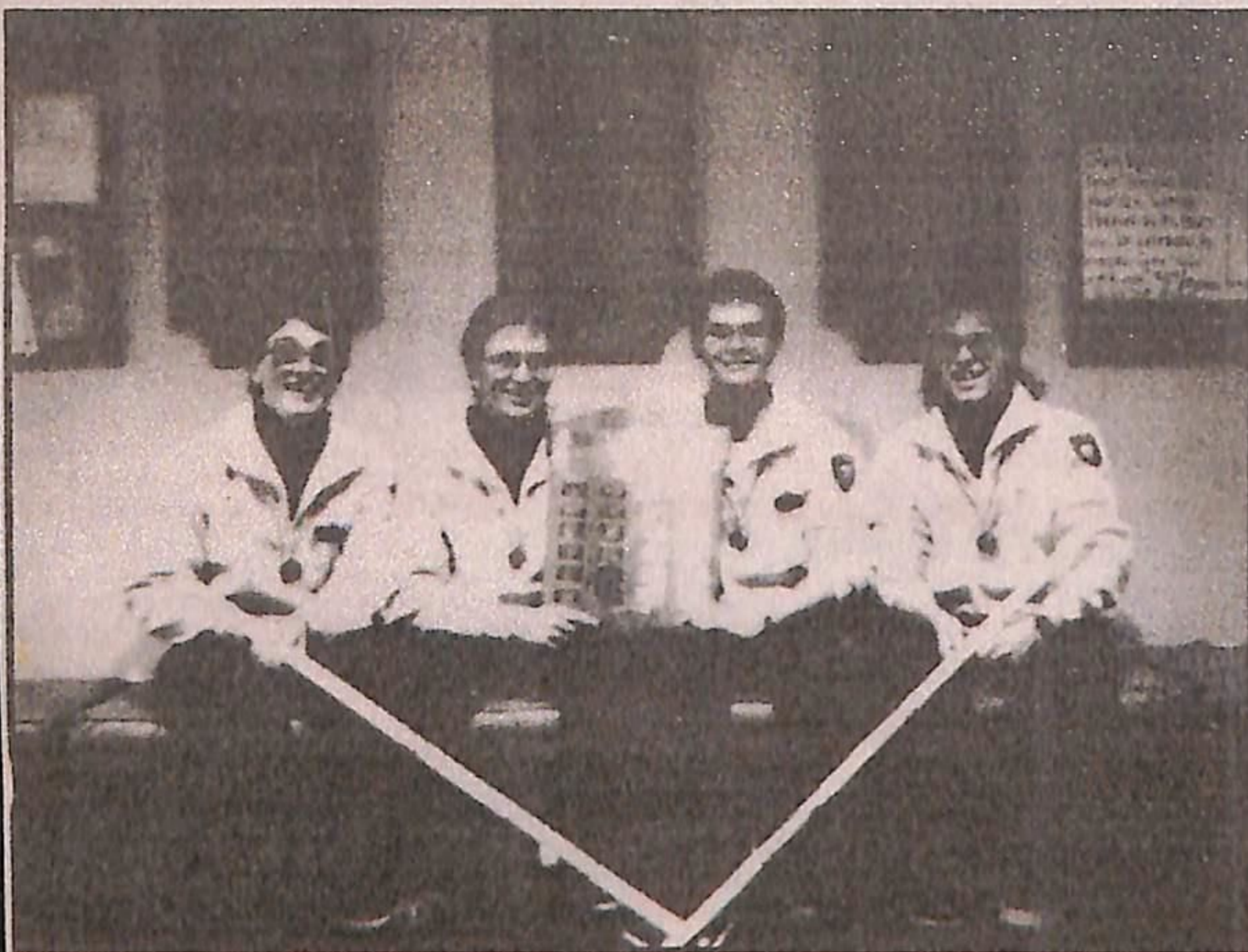


Chesley rink in provincial competition

Chesley District High School's curling team, skipped by Jamie Wark, lost 4-3 to Central Huron Secondary School of Clinton, in the final game Sunday of the Zone 13 Ontario Schoolboy Curling Playdowns, held at the Grey Granite Curling Club in Owen Sound.

Wark's rink "played well", coach Barry Mutrie said. "We shot well, but we were inconsistent putting up guards."

The competition started on Saturday when the CDHS rink met the same Clinton team in their first game and lost 8-3. In their second game of the day, Wark's rink met Saugeen District Secondary School of Port Elgin and won that game 8-2, giving them the Zone 13A title and championship plaque.

The team also played Listowel and won 8-3 in that game before losing in the final to Clinton.

Curling with Wark were Shannon Alpaugh, Trevor McLeod and Grant Nicholson.

Tuesday night, the team left for Kingston where they

will represent the Chesley Curling Club in the Ontario Pepsi Junior Men's Curling Playdowns.
