in 1941. The sisters sold it in 1945 to Neil Poole, who sold it to Bert Allan in 1946. They and their son, Stuart, lived there until 1955, when it was sold to Ronald Wolfe, and until 1956 when they moved to Chesley.

Ronald Wolfe was married to Elizabeth Vivian (Beth) MacGregor of Walkerton July 11, 1959, and moved into the house. At this time a well was drilled near the house to replace a dug well near the barn, and a bathroom and furnace were installed in the house.

In 1966 a large 5000 bushel grain bin was erected.

Mixed farming was carried on at this farm until the Wolfes bought it and used it for beef cattle only.

Ronald and Beth Wolfe have two children, Kathryn Elizabeth born November 21, 1961, and Deborah Anne born November 10, 1964.
