JULY

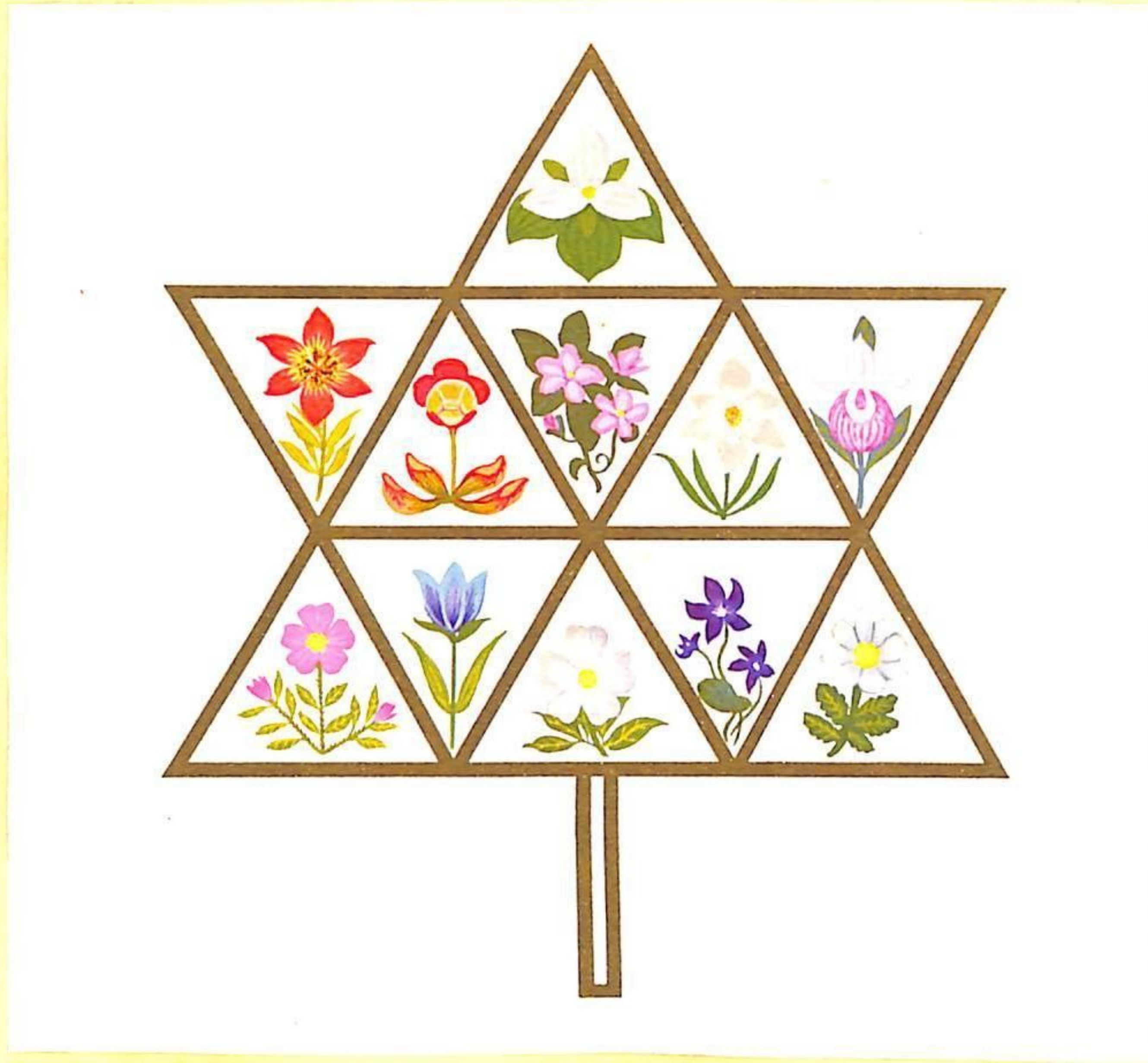
No meeting but had a Picnic in Willow Creek Park, each member brought an item for the program, a delicious picnic lunch was enjoyed by all.
