District president, who outlined the founding, organization, aims and purposes of the N. G. Mrs. R. G. Purcell, Provincial Federation representative, gave the N. G. connections with the Ontario Department of Agriculture, and with world affiliations. Mrs. J. Cooper, District Secretary then described the jubilee meeting held at Guelph and outlined the steps necessary to form a local organization. After some discussion and questions it was moved by Mrs. J. H. McEllen and seconded, that a local chapter be organized, and the following slate of officers was returned. President - Mrs. C. Hall, 1st Vice-President Mrs. H. Despins, 2nd Vice-President Mrs. L. Grace, Secretary - Treasurer - Mrs. H. Hansen, Branch Directors - Mrs. H. Bateman, Mrs. P. White and Mrs. J. McCabe. It was decided to leave the election of district director and auditors until the following meeting. It was moved by Mrs. E. Davis and seconded, that the local name of the organization would be the Red Rock Women's Institute, the meetings to be held on the third Wednesday of each month.
