Sawmills


Skipness has been noted for its sawmills. David Porter built the first sawmill on the farm now owned by John Reid in 1872. It was run by water power for fifteen years from a stream at Mud Lake, later called Maryville Lake. Mr. Porter bought the farm, now owned by Graham Chambers, in 1888. He died in 1890.

Joseph Chambers, brother-in-law of David Porter, ran the mill until 1900 when it was sold to the Reid brothers who owned and operated a sawmill at Zion Amabel corner, later the Forbes farm.

The Reids ran the sawmill until 1913 whe sold to Jack and Lowry Davidson. They moved to their farm on Lot 15 Concession 3.

The Davidson brothers ran the mill for sev then sold it to Mr. Tyson and Mr. Geddes of who ran it for five years.

In 1925 Robert Walker of Allenford bough and continued to run it until 1950 when it was to and moved to the south side of Highway 21 vson, Gerald, ran it for several years.
