Amendment Is Drafted

TORONTO (CP) - The Onto government has drafted an amendment to the provincial Human Rights Code that would bring the rental of flats in houses under the jurisdiction of the code, Labor Minister Gordon Carton said Tuesday.

Mr. Carton said the amendment to the code, which prohibits discrimination in rental of accommodation, will be introduced at the next session of the Ontario legislature.

He said in an interview that the proposed change would overcome a decision by the Supreme Court of Canada that found that flats in houses are not covered by the legislation because they are not self-contained.
