COMES UP AGAIN  
The Vietminh Comm. members raised the question last week. Western delegates to get the discussions back to ending the fighting in China, flatly refused the proposal.

Conference sources also expressed hope that the delegates might come down to a study of drafts of armistice proposals, particularly their military aspects. This led some Westerners to believe that the Communists might again drop the issue of the rebel groups in Laos and Cambodia.

The Western powers limit discussion to key points in the opening of the negotiations. France's foreign minister Bidault, however, touched on the controversy over Laos and Cambodia by demanding that Communist forces be withdrawn from the two Indo-China domains.

A major provision of the plan for ending hostilities in China was that the Vietminh in Laos and Cambodia be withdrawn from the proposed ar-
