Instruction

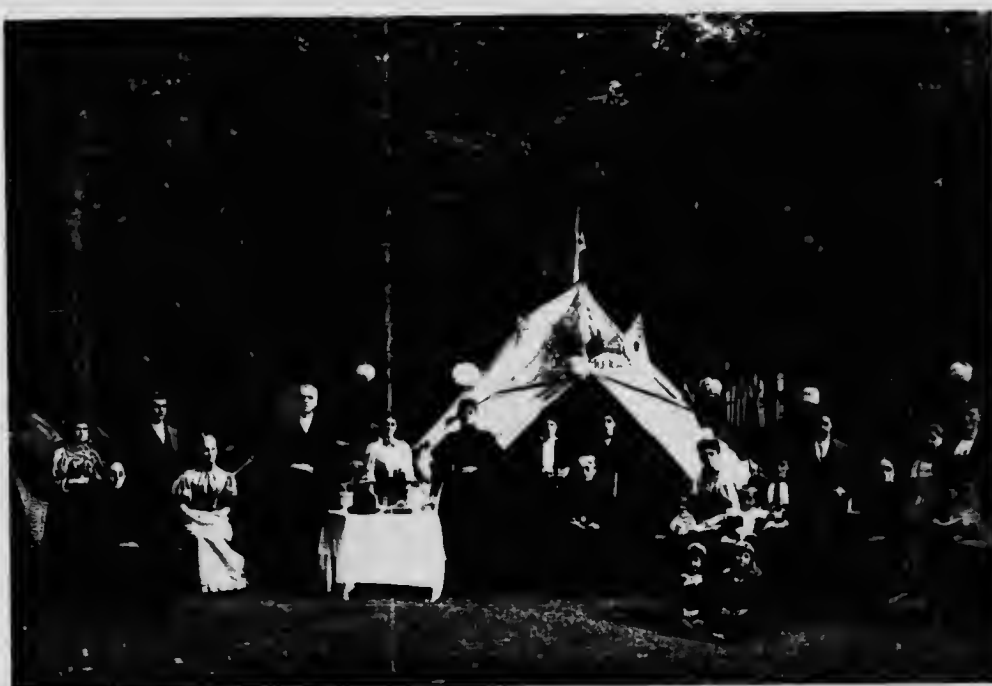
Arrangements are being perfected for classes in music, sewing, painting, also for a kindergarten. Information may be obtained by addressing the Resident Manager.
