HOW TO GET THERE

Grimsby Beach is on the main line of the Grand Trunk Railway, midway between Niagara Falls and Hamilton. The Grand Trunk Station is directly at the gates of the Park, within easy walking distance of the hotel and cottages. The Lake View Hotel and Park House porters and teams will meet all trains, of which there are several each day.

Electric Line

Parties coming by way of Hamilton can take the Hamilton, Grimsby and Beamsville Electric cars, hourly, direct to the gates of the Park. It is a beautiful ride along the main road from Hamilton to Niagara Falls. Before the end of 1910, it is anticipated that the Electric road will be completed to St. Catharines, giving connection all the way to the Falls.

Hamilton and Toronto Steamboats

At this writing, May 1st, arrangements have not been completed for direct Steamboat service to Toronto, but every indication points to a daily service during July and August. The H. G. & B. Electric Railway has made special arrangements with the Hamilton Steamboats and the Turbinia Steamboat Co., to carry passengers from Toronto to Grimsby Beach and return, or vice-versa, for \$1.15.
