rascals who were about to raid this country. All he had to say in conclusion was that he was ready to shoulder the rifle and march to the front. The next speaker was Mr. B., an elderly man and a Catholic, who said: 'Mr. Chairman and neighbors, I believe this is the first time I ever stood on a platform with the intention of making anything like a speech. I agree with the previous speaker, that this is a critical time, with the Fenians on our borders or it may be in the act of crossing, and 'by the boys sired,' (which was an expression the old man used when he was more in earnest than usual) worse than all if it is true that the Irish Catholics in Canada are ready with pikes and guns to assist them; but, gentlemen, it is a lie as far as the Catholics of this neighborhood are concerned. I came from the County Down, in Ireland, where we were annoyed, and I might add disgraced by the plotting, quarreling, fighting and midnight raids of Ribbon men, White Boys and Orangemen and hoped that this country would be free from such societies. I never belonged to one of them in my life, and I am sorry to know that some of my neighbors think it necessary to get up nights for fear that we will murder them in their beds; what have we been doing to cause this suspicion? Do not be afraid to go to your beds and sleep soundly, no harm shall come to you from us, and when your young men go to the front ours shall go with them, (cheers) and stand shoulder to shoulder with yours, forming an impassable barrier to the foe, neither asking nor caring who they are. Gentlemen, did we forsake you at Waterloo, Balaklava or Inkermann. It grieves me to think that there are a few who have believed lying rumors of our treason, still, I am not afraid to trust those young men who have been with us from childhood, who have helped to clear our farms and have been fellow-workers through trials and difficulties. Well all I have to say is that when you leave home to risk your lives for your country, that the confidence and brotherly love which has always existed between us shall continue.'

As there were no more speakers, the following motion was made and carried: "This meeting is of the opinion that it is the duty of loyal Canadians to discountenance all secret societies of a political or religious nature, that have any tendency to foster or revive the animosities that have destroyed the peace and happiness of Ireland; that we, as loyal Canadians, have nothing to do with the quarrels of foreigners. H. Wilson moved that a committee of five should be appointed, with authority to call a meeting any time they thought necessary and that they should take the names of all persons wishing to join our forces for active duty, and also caution Sandy and Pat Murphy to be more careful about their statements in future." The meeting then broke up with three cheers for the volunteers.

The committee met on the 22nd Dec. and made the following report: "Almost all our young men are ready for duty. Sandy and Murphy have gone over to McGraw's and will be detained there a few days, as the river has risen and carried off the bridge."

How those gentlemen got along the few days they were with McGraw, I am not able to state, as McGraw left those parts soon after and I have never seen him since and Sandy and Pat were unwilling to talk on the subject.

The Fenians were disorganized, the American government having interfered with them. The committee never met again.

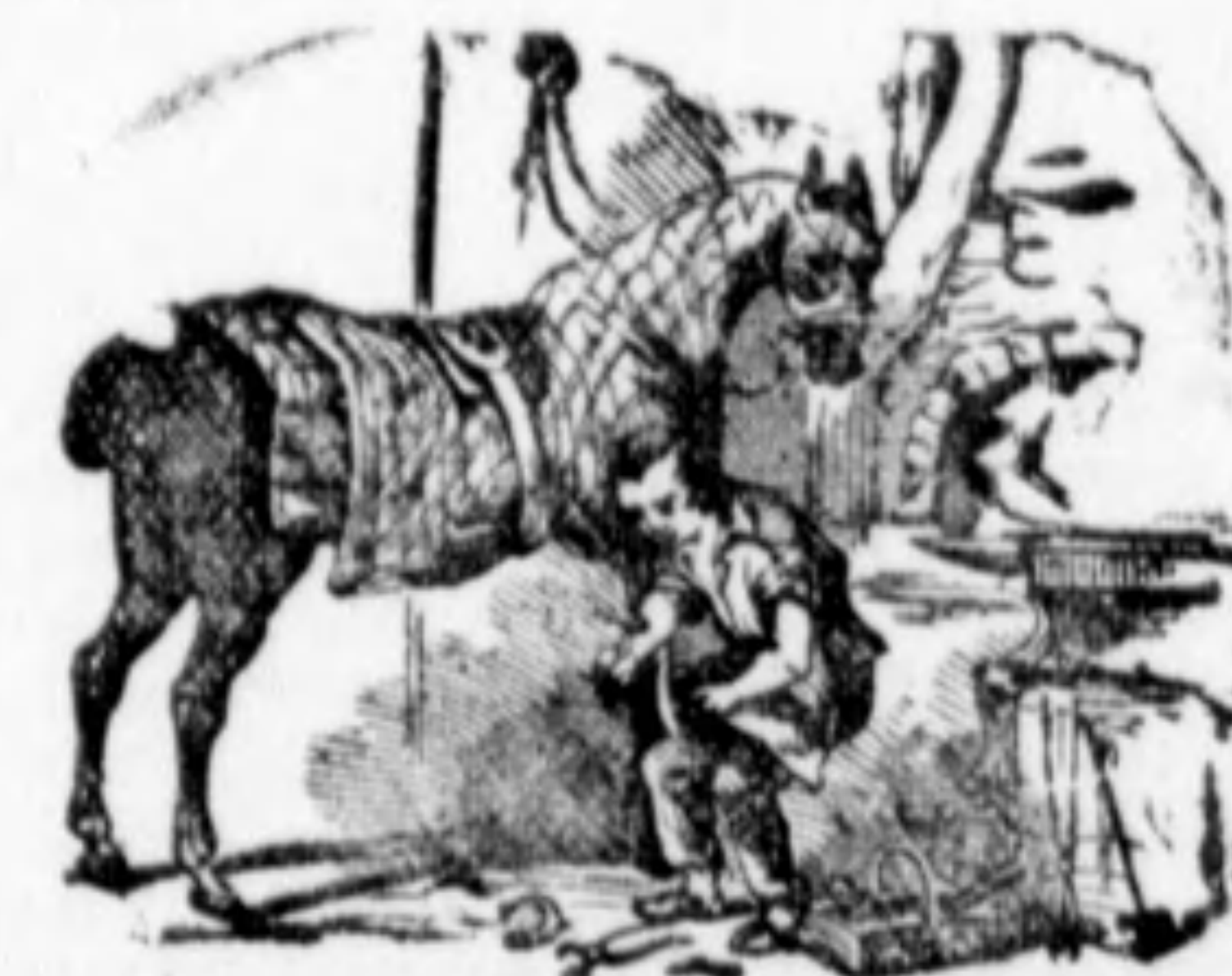
