Fall Assizes.

From the Advertiser.

The Assize of this week was probably one of the shortest on record here, concluding at half-past 10 Wednesday, after a session of only an hour or so over one day.

The following Grand Jurors were in attendance:—Thos. Gilray, Peter Gerard, John Zeigler, John Nicol, John Sword, Wm. F. Hewgill, Thos. McClelland, Robt. Heron, Matthew Kennedy, Jas. Erskine, Jos. A. Dickson, Robt. Abercrombie, Jas. Gilchrist, Joseph Randall, John Arnott, John A. McMillan, Wm. Hampton, Solomon Hill, Geo. Taylor, Wm. Vaustone, John Sutherland, W. F. C. Arliage.

Weed vs. Sullivan was the first case heard, being a prosecution for illegal seizure and conversion of goods. Plaintiff lives in Owen Sound and Defendant in Gore Bay. Verdict for the plaintiff for \$1435. J. W. Frost for Plif. Case undefended.

Queen vs. Wilkinson was a charge of False Pretence, arising out of a cattle deal between George Boyd and W. J. Wilkinson, the former claiming that the defendant had induced Mrs. Boyd to sell the cattle by untruly stating that he (Mr. Boyd) had expressed his assent to the bargain. Verdict, Not Guilty. Alfred Frost for the Crown; J. W. Frost for the Deft.

McLauchlan vs. McNichol was an action brought by James McLauchlan, of Owen Sound, to set aside as fraudulent a conveyance made between two brothers. Defts. live at Providence Bay. Judgement was given for the plaintiff. J. M. Kilbourn and H. G. Tucker for the Plif. James Masson Q. C., and S. Masson for Deft.

Queen vs. Chas. Richardson—Mr. Richardson was charged with having received \$57 from David Gibson, of Owen Sound, on a mortgage, after he had sold the mortgage and had no longer a right to collect the amount. The Judge withdrew the case from the Jury, as he held that the fraud had not been made out.

James McKilvery fell under a wagon near Shelburne Saturday and the wheels passed over his head, killing him instantly.
