COUNTY AND DISTRICT.

Elmwood postoffice was burglarized recently and forty-five dollars stolen.

The boy Hanbury, who was injured by a horse bolting at Walters Falls fair, has recovered.

Premier Abbott and Hon. Mr. Foster left Montreal for England, on Friday, on the steamer Parisian

There is much anxiety regarding the fate of Capt. Lawlor, who left Boston in June for a trip across the ocean in a twelve-foot canvas boat.

R. J. K. Gore has been committed for trial at Goderich on a charge of perjury. Gore is the man who originated the scandal against Mr. M. C. Cameron.

A statement has been received at the Department of Marine showing that the Russian cruisers operating in Bering Sea have captured ten Canadian sealing schooners valued at \$76,000 and 1,900 seal-skins worth \$10 each.

Mr. George Heinzmann, painter in the Hanover, Ont., furniture factory, dropped dead while at his work on Saturday afternoon. He was about 67 years of age and was apparently in good health up to the time of his death. He leaves a wife, three daughters and a son.

Messrs. Crossley and Hunter, the evangelists, have done a good work in Warton. It is rumored that the reeve has decided to turn over a new leaf and will drop the suit against Brother Cross of the Echo. If this be true it is at least a favorable sign that he really does wish to do better.

Hanford Fox, who administered a severe castigation to Dr. Oldham, of Chatsworth, the principal in the unsavory scandal of that village, and afterward assaulted Constable Galbraith, and was committed to goal for trial, appeared before Judge Creasor on Monday. He pleaded guilty to the charge of assaulting an officer while in the discharge of his duty, and was sentenced to thirty days in goal. —[O. S. Times.
