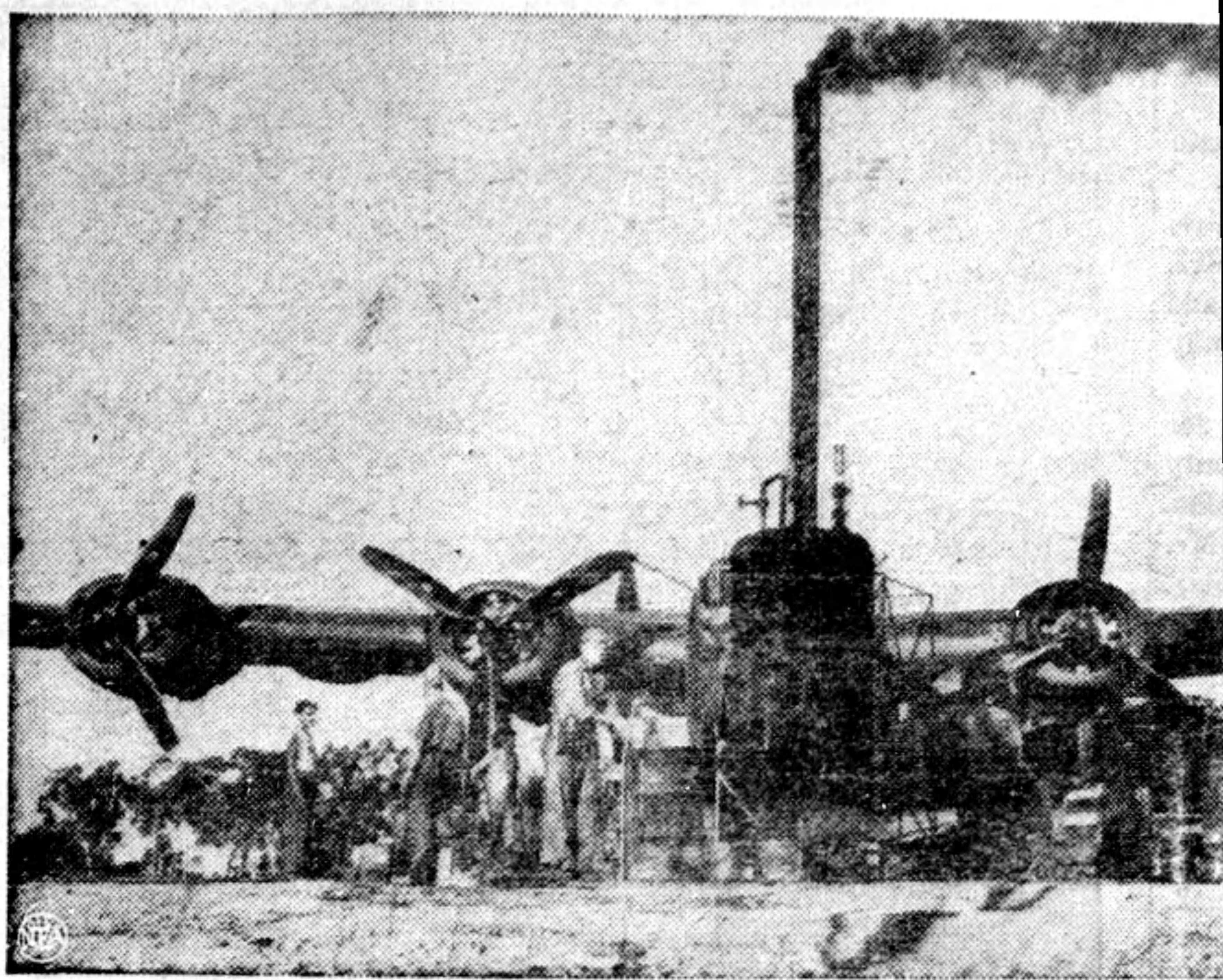


DO YOU SEE WHAT I SEE?
