The fire originated from a spark from the burning swamp on the premises, and spread through the barn with such rapidity that the stall and horse were enveloped in flames before Mr. McNeill could get into the building, who had a narrow escape with his life in trying to save the property. No insurance.

GREAT CONFLAGRATION.

Our village people were aroused from their slumber on Monday evening about two o'clock by the cry of "Fire! Fire!" Flames were discovered bursting from the upper part of the building occupied by Mr. Bain as a millinery store, and connecting with Mr. John Hamilton's shed and hotel.
The fire was first noticed by Mr. Bain, who gave the alarm. Mr. Duffy arose terrified lest the flames should reach his place, which was just across the street. He aroused the neighborhood, and very soon a crowd had congregated, and set to work with a will to save furniture, and to stay the progress of the flames.
A small hand engine belonging to Mr. McGill was soon on the ground, and did valuable service in saving the house occupied by Miss Garrett, dressmaker, it being only a few feet from the burning building.
All hope of saving Mr. Hopkins' buildings was given up, and the contents were speedily removed, very little being left in them of much value. About 70 cords of wood were consumed in the yard, and the stable loft which had recently been filled with hay was speedily burned. The furniture was badly damaged in moving it from the house.
In the meantime, the front and the roofs of the buildings on the opposite side of the street were kept well drenched with water.
A desperate heat was thrown out while the outhouses were burning, which for a time endangered the row of small buildings south of the fire, but no further damage was done in that direction.
All this time a great struggle was going on in order to save Miss Garrett's dressmaking establishment, and at length the efforts of the workers were successful.
It was fortunate that the morning was calm, otherwise it would have been impossible to have stayed the progress of the devouring element, as it was the northern portion of the village received a shower of burning cinders, which would have been the means of fresh fires had they not been closely watched and speedily watered. All worked like heroes, both male and female, in carrying water, saving goods, &c.
The fire was, without doubt the work of an incendiary, and strong suspicions are entertained against a well-known resident of our usually quiet village.
Mr. Hopkins' loss is \$3,500. He is insured in the Citizens Company for \$2000.
There is said to be no insurance on Mrs. Bain's buildings. Mr. Hopkins has not yet decided whether he will rebuild.
