Some Seasonable Dishes.

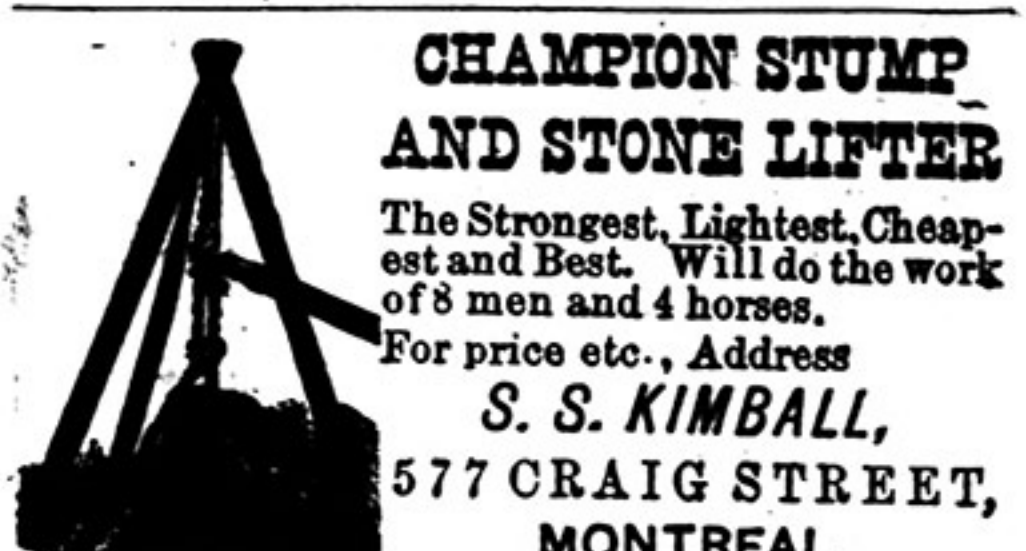
