C. P. R. CAR SHOPS.

New Buildings just Completed at Winnipeg—the first Car ever made in Manitoba.

Winnipeg, Jan. 21.—The Canadian Pacific railway car shops, the construction of which was commenced three months ago, are now completed. They consist of an erection shop and a two-story work shop for machinery, etc. The new buildings are heated throughout with steam. They are for the repairing of cars. The erecting shop is a one story shed 200x95 feet, and contains three tracks, capable of accommodating three coaches each. Here the injured coaches are painted and their wounds dressed. There are facilities for employing 30 or 40 carpenters, and as many painters. There are at present eight coaches undergoing repairs. The ground flat of the two story building will be devoted to manufacturing wood work and machinery. It will employ some 18 or 20 men, and contain 14 machines. Up-stairs is the pattern and cabinet shops. Here there will be seven wood working machines. In the southeaster corner is the upholstering department, partitioned off from the rest of the shop. About 20 men will be employed on this flat. The greater part of the machinery has been obtained from Cant, Gourlay & Co., Galt, Ont., the remainder coming from Tay & Co., Cincinnati.

A new car is being built here for Superintendent Egan. This will be the official car, and is the first car ever made in Manitoba. When completed it will bid fair to rival the productions of the older makers. It is being made, for the most part, by hand, and will be about the most costly car on the road. It is made with oak sills, the body being of hard pine, with panels of whitewood and ash. It is lined with paper inside and out, and will be heated with a sear-heater. There will be no regular sleeping berth, a convertible couch being substituted. The whole will be upholstered in a crimson plush.
