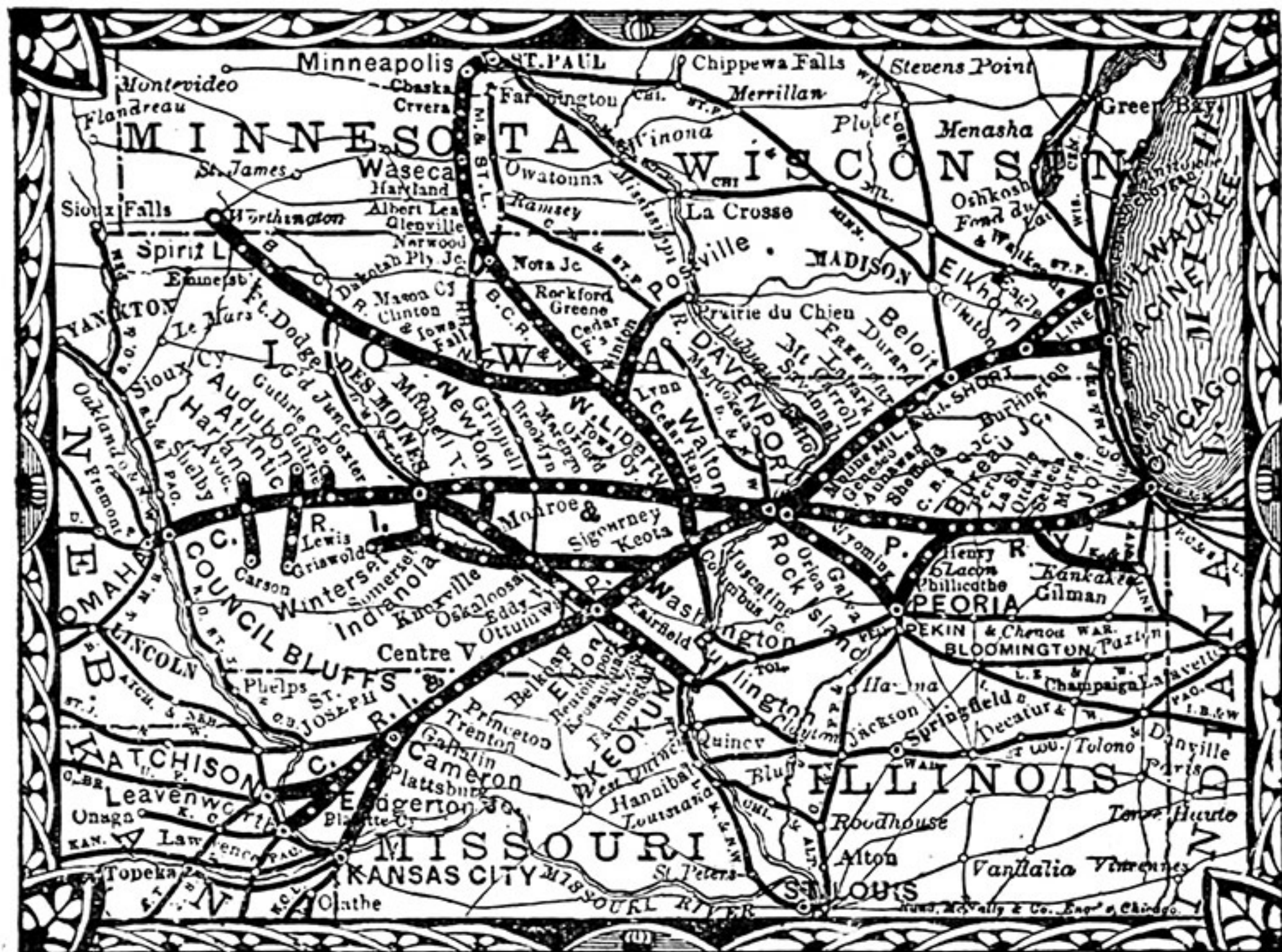

**AROUND THE STATION.**—The railway authorities are making extensive improvements and alterations, in preparation for the opening of navigation increased business which will be done through Owen Sound this season. The esplanade south of the present passenger depot is being prepared for a coal dock, and extensive sheds are being erected. The marsh is also being graded, and a gravel train is kept at work filling it up so as to make more room for sidings and other facilities for the handling of freight. The elevator is progressing rapidly, and will be ready for the reception of grain shortly after the opening of navigation. The C. P. R. boats are expected to leave Port Colborne for here as soon as the ice will permit.—O. S. Advertiser.

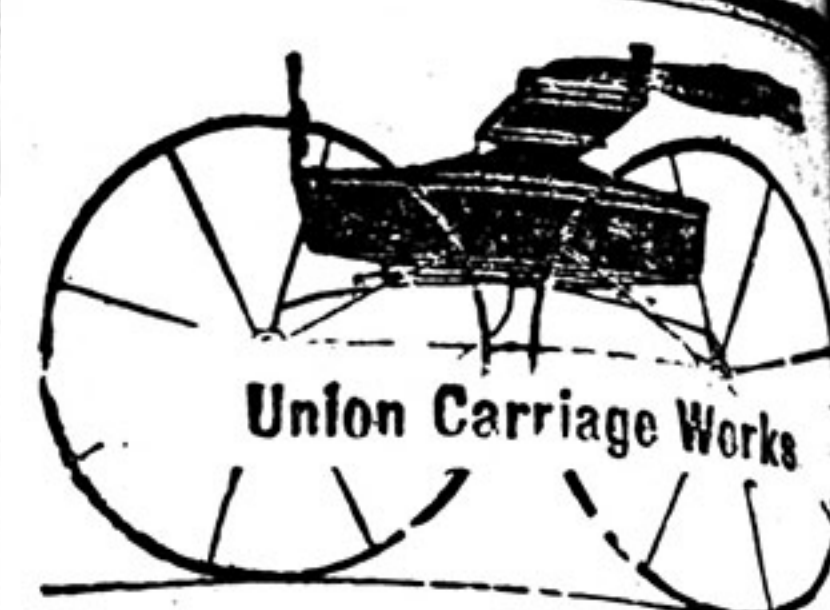
