Last winter reports from the differ-
ent States showed that in nearly all
of them, while the weather was not so
steady as in Ontario, there was greater
extremes of cold, the thermometer
registering often lower in the Southern
States than in Toronto. During the
late cold dip considerable damage was
done by frost in some parts of Ontario,
but in parts of New York State ice
formed three-quarters of an inch thick.
At Hanover, N. H., the ground was
frozen solid, and in other places in
that State there were several inches
of snow. That is a worse record than
any part of settled Ontario can show.
Evidently the idea that the climate
becomes more unbearable with every
inch toward the north is wrong. The
people of the States immediately south
of Canada look upon this county as a
land of everlasting cold. The people
of southern Ontario look upon the
unsettled part of the province to the
north in much the same way. Perhaps
time will show that they too are mis-
taken.

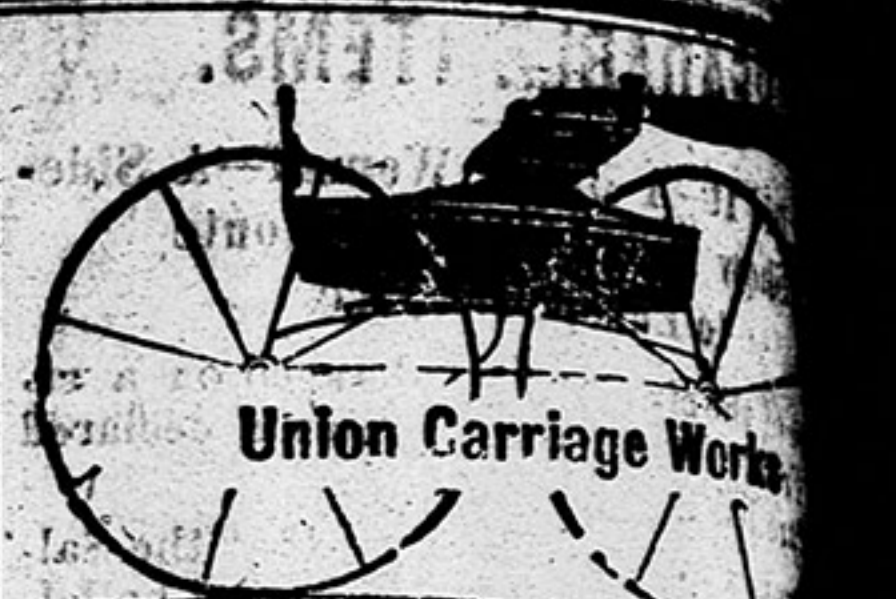
