 ment.—Grey Review.

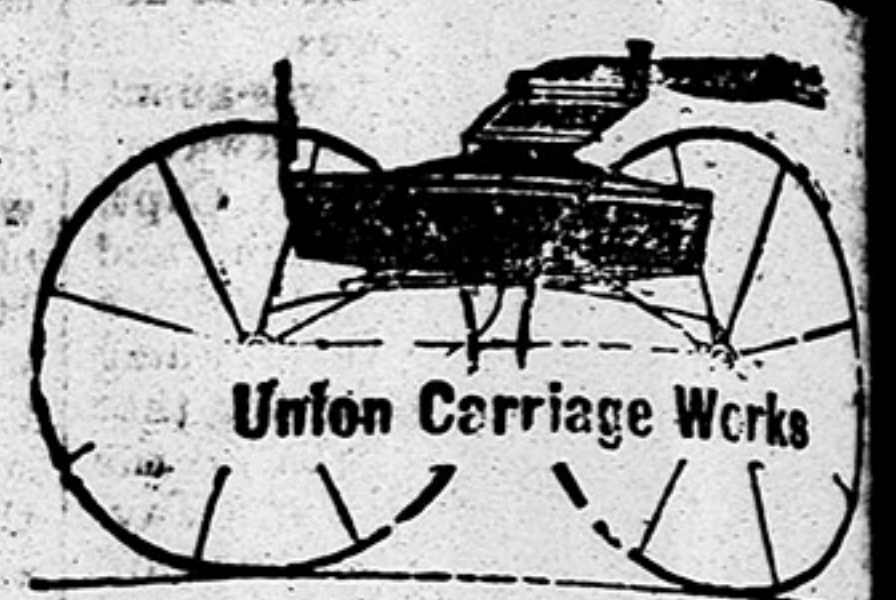

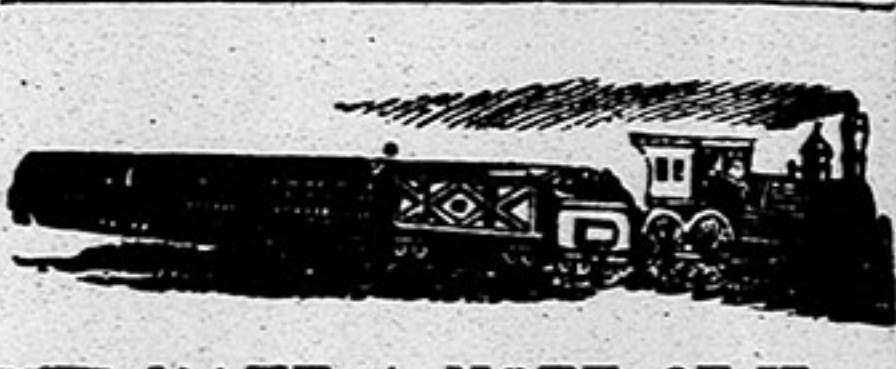
