The facts of this case are beyond dispute. Col. Houston was bitten on the culf of the right leg by a large rattlesnake, was treated by a million or so of mosquitoes, and entirely recovered. This establishes beyond possibility of doubt that inculation with mosquito poison is an antidote to rattlesnake poison- a fact which will henceforth deprive the rattlesnake of all his peculiar ter-
