Storing Ice.

Every family should have ice for the summer. Hence build an ice house. Select some spot shaded if possible and protected from the wind. Every ice house should have a kind of cellar dug, which must be filled up with stones covered with a layer of sand. This will permit the water to escape. On the foundation place a common sill; on this put the plank upright and nail outside boards well batted; inside any rough boards will hollow and thus prevent conduction disordered LIVER, KIDNEYS, STOMACH, of heat from the heated atmosphere; the space must be filled with saw-dust, tanbark or rough course chaff. Roof of common boards is all that is needed, well batted. Opening should be left on each gable end to permit a free draft. Door should be double and layer to fill up the crevices and prevent entrance of air. At first a layer of saw-duss should be put on floor at and this space should be filled with saw-dust. Over the top layer a good thickness of saw-dust or whatever other material is used.




