East Grey Teachers' Association will meet in Flesherton on October 25 and 26.

GENERAL NEWS.

Dakota's Wheat Crop.
MINNEAPOLIS, Sept. 30.—W. J. Sheridan, territorial statistician of Dakota, estimates the wheat crop at 88,000,000 bushels, against 83,000,000 bushels produced in the territory last year.

Wingham Bonus By-Laws Carried.
WINGHAM, Ont., Sept. 29.—The by-laws were voted on here to-day for the purpose of granting \$20,000 to furniture manufacturers in this town, all of which were carried by large majorities. Gilchrist, Green & Co. of the Union furniture factory were granted \$10,000; T. Dell & Co. \$5,000, and Kincaid Bros., chair factory \$5,000. The factories have agreed to bring a large number of skilled workmen into the town and put up suitable buildings.
