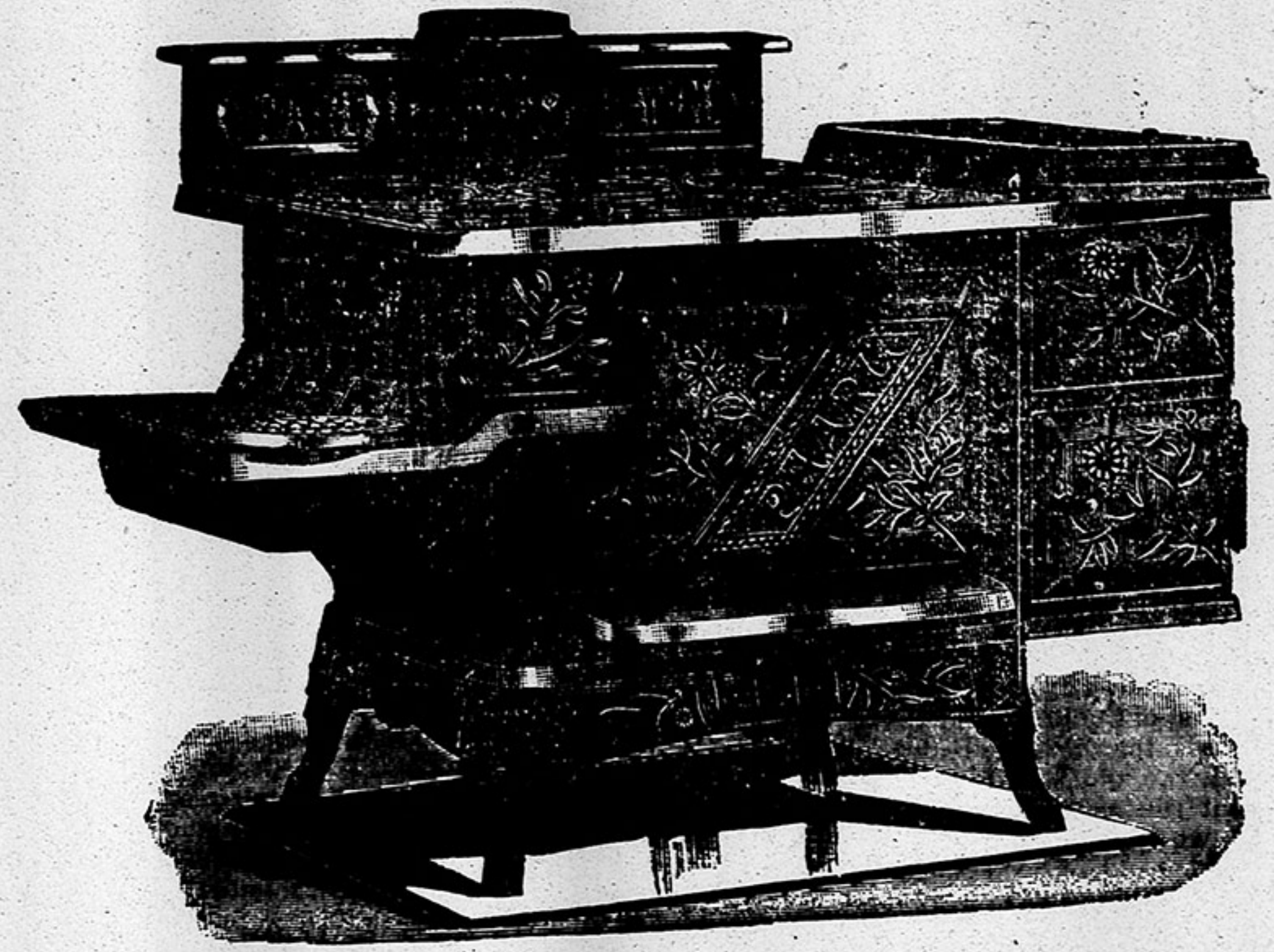

### Holland Council.

Holland Centre, July 10th, 1890.  
Holland Council met on above date for the transaction of business.

Reeve in the chair; members all present.

Minutes of meeting of June 9th and of Court of Revision, of the same date, read, approved and signed.

A communication was read from Masson & Masson re arrears of taxes on lots 6 and 7, Douglas St. Williamsford.

The following accounts were presented: D. Mattheson, for repairs to buggy; T. J. Spears, 4 road scrapers, \$96. Clerk for stationery and postage, \$9.25. C Price, balance of salary and stationery, 1888.

Foster—Shute—That we refund \$1.50 to Duncan Mattheson for roadwork done for part of lot 4, concession 7, E. G. R., Holland, for 1889.—Carried.

Galbraith—Foster—That Duncan Mattheson get an order for \$2, as part recompense for damages done to his buggy by a deficient culvert on No. 6 sideline.—Carried.

Shute—Hampton—That we grant an equivalent to repair the Sink Hole on 80 sideroad, as granted by Glenelg.—Carried.

Hampton—Shute—That this council grant \$20, to cut hill, on con. 2, W, T. and S. R., opposite lot 43.—Carried.  
Shute—Hampton—That we grant \$15 on the extension of 50 sideroad, on con. 2, E. G. R.—Carried.

Galbraith—Foster—That we grant \$80, on townline Holland and Euphrasia, provided Euphrasia grant an equivalent.—Carried.

Shute—Hampton—That we grant \$50 to the hill on townline, Holland and Glenelg, west of the 6th con. in case Glenelg grant an equivalent.—Carried.

Foster—Shute—That we grant \$10 on con. 11, lots 12 and 13.—Carried.

Shute—Hampton—That this council pay their share of taking off the water let in by building culvert from Sullivan's side of the village of Chatsworth, and that we ask Sullivan to pay one half of the same.—Carried.

Shute—Galbraith—That the Clerk notify Mr. Marquis to appear next meeting to explain an item in the roll of 1887 which concern him.—Carried.

Shute—Foster—That we grant \$5 on the application of Mr. McCann, to

gravel crossway on 40 sideroad.—Carried.

Galbraith—Hampton—That Thos. J. Spears get an order for \$36 for 4 road scrapers.—Carried.

Galbraith—Foster—That we grant \$25 to the Agricultural Societies, viz: \$15 to the Holland Agricultural Society and \$10 to the Walter's Falls Central provided the other Townships concerned grant the same.—Carried.

Hampton—Shute—That we grant \$40 to be expended on 20 sideroad, west of Toronto and Sydenham road.—Carried.

Galbraith—Hampton—That the Clerk get an order for \$85 as part salary for 1890.—Carried.

Foster—Hampton—That we grant \$5 for culvert, on 2nd con. E. G. R., opposite lot 52.—Carried.

Hampton—Foster—That we give a special grant of \$25 to cut hill and build culvert, on Phillip's hill, con. 8 and 9.—Carried.

Hampton—Shute—That the bill of C. Price be laid over to next meeting for further information in the matter.—Carried.

Hampton—Foster—That the bill of the Clerk for express, stationery, &c., amounting to \$9.25, be paid.—Carried.

The Council then adjourned till Friday September 5th.
