

Council again went into committee on the whole on by-law to re-appoint Valuers, and consider the following clauses, as follows: clause 2, providing that Valuers prepare proper books to record the progress of their labours; clause 3, providing the time when they should commence their work (fill up with Feb. 15th); clause 4, instructing them to ascertain the relative value of all property in each municipal district, that they should note the general character of the different parts of each township—swamps, sand, good land, &c.; clause 6, that they should fix the average value of each township to the best of their judgment, with due reference to the amount of cleared land, facilities for traffic, &c.; clause 7, that the several towns and villages should be separately taken into consideration in making up their valuation; clause 8, that any other matter they may consider of importance to this Council should be included in their reports; clause 9, that they should report in writing to the Council when through with their work; clause 10, that their remuneration should be \$3 per day for their expenses, stationery, &c. An additional clause was moved by Mr. Colman, that this By-law come into force on Feb. 15th next, which was the previous clauses was passed by a majority of the whole. The Council adjourned till 9 o'clock on Saturday morning.

shall give without exaggeration. Say each municipality in the county of Grey has 400 farmers raising on an average 10 acres of Spring wheat averaging 15 bushels per acre. This would be for each township 60,000 bushels by sowing new seed; the yield would be increased say 2 1/2 bushels to the acre. This would be, as you can readily see, 10,000 bushels gained for the county or 170,000 bushels for the county of Grey, and for the Province of Ontario a gain of 833,000 bushels in Spring wheat, not speaking of seed barley which on change of seed would be equally profitable. Now I am positive that all farmers who know what change of seed grain means will agree with me that I have made a very low calculation regarding the profits which might be expected from the change of seed grain referred to. I ask is not the matter well worthy the consideration of any Government if they could see their way clear to let the farmers' wives make the butter and they to work and import good seed grain. Sir John would throw off the duties on railroads, no doubt, in Canada would carry at low rates and seed could be supplied to farmers at a reasonable cost. The agriculturalists by this act would at once derive a great benefit. It would contribute largely to the prosperity of our country. In two or three months the Government would get back their money with the assurance that they had done a good deed and nobody hurt.
