Raising Turkeys.

The Poultry's World gives the following good advice for making turkeys profitable.

There are some pretty and showy varieties of fancy turkeys, but the only breed that is profitable on the farm is the Bronze turkey. The Bronze is a cross between the old common black or Narragansett turkey and the wild turkey. The wild bird is the finest specimen of this fowl in existence, but it cannot be domesticated. The gobbler of the wild turkey is sometimes captured weighing it pounds. The Bronze gobbler attains even a larger growth, reaching occasionally nearly 50 pounds. But for breeding purposes the male bird should not weigh over 30 pounds, or the female over 18 or less than 14 pounds.

Old birds make the best breeders. Their chie in this field is greatest from two years

due in this field is greatest from two years all up to 12. The bronze turkey retains the wild instinct, so far as to be possessed of a mains for stealing its nest out and hiding it. Mr. I. K. Felch directs the poultry raiser to humor this fancy of the hen turkey so far as to cheat her into the belief that she is hiding her nest. He lays a barrel upon its side on the ground and then buries it in the soil to one third of its diameter. He puts earth into it up even with the ground of the outside and covers it with sod. The currents of the ocean are the great transporters of the sun's heat from the torid zone to temper the climate of the polar regions, says John E. Pillsbury in the Century. It is argued by some that such a stupendous change as that which, occurred in Europe and America at the time of the glands. Europe and America at the time of the gla-cial period was caused simply by a deflec-tion in the currents in the northern hemis-phere, whereby its share of tropical heat was partly diverted toward the south.
