




Suicide in The German Army. The Militar-Wochenblatt gives some in

teresting statistics as to the number of cases of suicide in the German army. The most important fact which they record is that during the last year fower cases of suicides were recorded in the Prussian suicides were recorded in the Prussian army than in any year since 1873. The report lays stress on the fact that suicides in general are of much more frequent occurrence in countries with a Germanic than in those with a Slav or Romanic population. In Germany, which stands first on the list, there is a yearly average of 2.71 suicides to every 10 000 of the population, while in France, Austria, Henzland, and Italy the averages are 1.87, 1.63, 1.76, and 16, respectively. As regards suicides in the army, Alistria comes first with 12 53 to every 10,000 mon, followed by Germany with 6.3, Italy with 4, France with 3.23, England with 2.09. These figures are unfortunately not quite complete or up to date, some of the extention of the ex

Englant with 2.09. Those-figures are un fortunately not quite complete or up to date, some of the statistics failing for Bavaria, saxony, and Wurtemborg. Equally incomplete are the results of the investigations to the causes of suicide in the army, it having been found impracticable to discover the readons in one-third of the instances. As far as known, the fear of punishment for misconduct plays the chief part in driving soldiers to solf-destruction; and it is worthy of notice that twice as many non-commissioned officers as privates fall by their own hand in the course of the fall by their own hand in the co A.
