Week's Commercial Summary.

The general condition of business can hardly be said to have shown any decided improvement during the past week. The prolonged uncertainty as to the ultimate arrangement of the tariff with regard to high grade woollens prevents orders being placed, and has depressed the price of wool. Heavy supplies of U. S. cattle in Britain make a drop in prices among the things which may be looked for. Money, however, continues cheap and the crop prospects are good.

Exports, the product of Canada from the city of Toronto in the month of April aggregated \$27,945, the principal items being animals and their products \$17,000, and agricultural products \$83,000. Exports for the same month make a grand total of \$1,885,948, the duty paid being \$22,724.00 or about 2% on the total. The highest duty paid is on refined coal oil and kerosene oil \$8.50 worth having been paid on \$1,000 worth of oil, about 85 per cent.

A bill was recently introduced into the United States Senate to impose an annual tax on commercial travellers from foreign countries of \$1,000 per annum, and to punish the infringement of this regulation by a fine of \$500. The Legislature of Prince Edward Island has recently passed a law to regulate transient or casual travellers \$15 a year.

The Canadian Pacific traffic returns for week ending May 7 again show a decrease of \$11,000, or nearly 12 per cent, as compared with last year.

The municipalities in Canada for the week ending May 12 is again in excess of the corresponding period in last year, being 12 as against 23, and as against 31 the previous year. None were of great importance and for the first time in many months the failures in the Province of Quebec were greater than those in Ontario, being 10 to 11.

A bill was introduced in the House of Commons to supply by which the water supply of the English lakes in Cumberland county, 50 miles away, has been found and the water supplied to the city of the best quality in quantities sufficient for all practical needs. The City of York is a city of 200,000 people and is supplied by a drainage system that works by on and off the flow of the great basin to the sea, but they are not fighting the natural laws of gravitation.

The Official Gazette publishes an order directing that Canadian cattle imported to England be marked at the point of exportation and be isolated and killed if they are found to be infected with such cattle as not to be removed without the permission of the Inspector of the Board of Husbandry. In addition the lungs of these cattle are to be kept in a special room and examined by the inspectors. The order went into force on May 17.

The Imperial Agricultural Board has decided to issue a report on the condition of the sheep in the Dominion. It is a mistake to assume that the facilities exist for passing cattle from the Western States of America into Manitoba and the Northwest. This statement is appropriate because it is evident that the Board of Agriculture has had stress upon that they consider an opening for the importation of such stock.
