Letter Postage  
The reduced letter postal rates between Canada and the United Kingdom, British India, Newfoundland, British East Africa, Uganda, Zanzibar, British Central Africa, the Niger coast protectorate and the Niger Company's territory, from five to two cents per cent to come into effect on Christmas day. That day being Sunday we presume the following day will be the correct date. Our Canadian letter postage remains the same as at present yet how long is not yet known.

Division Court
