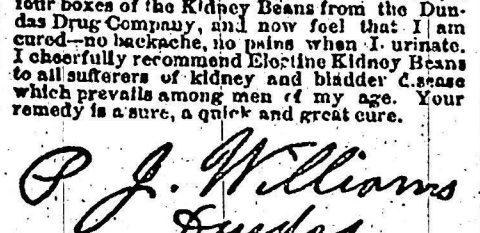
**The National Prayer**
