We are to consider milk precisely as means of drainage by which the system of the cow, is relieved of much mischievous matter that is productive of disease in animals or persons who use the milk, but most especially it is the human infant that suffers seriously in those cases in which for unavoidable reasons a substitute is necessarily used for its natural supply. The milk of the best managed dairy needs all the precautions that are possible. Not only should the most scrupulous cleanliness, even purity, be exercised in every way, in the selection and use of food, and mostly of water, but equally in the personal cleanliness of the cows, and as well the cleanliness of the stable and the purity of the air breathed, which should be purified by ample ventilation. In all ways every precaution should be taken to insure wholesome ness in the dairy, and then-lest any defect might exist - these measures of purifying the milk should be known and studied, and in any case of doubt they should be put to use.
