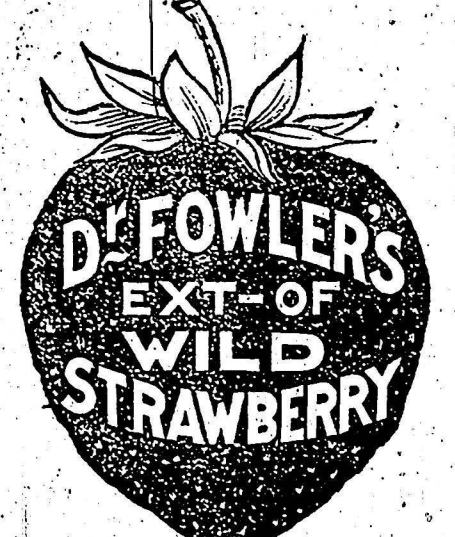

The Square Timber Trade.

The Canada Lumberman for April says: It is not a cause of regret that the square timber trade of Canada is gradually passing into history.

Looking at the question from all sides, we cannot conceive of any loss, either financial or industrial, that has resulted from the lessened exports of square timber.

In the past the farmer has been misled to some extent by the seemingly fancy prices offered by square timber jobbers. Not being familiar with timber measurements the farmer is prone to accept, without investigation, the prices which would seem to offer him the greatest returns.

Let us take for example a log 30 feet in length and 20 inches in diameter. Such a log would make 38 cubic feet of square timber, equal to 450 superficial feet board measure.

The foregoing remarks are intended to show that viewing the question from a national standpoint, the decadence of the square timber-trade is after all but a boon to the country.

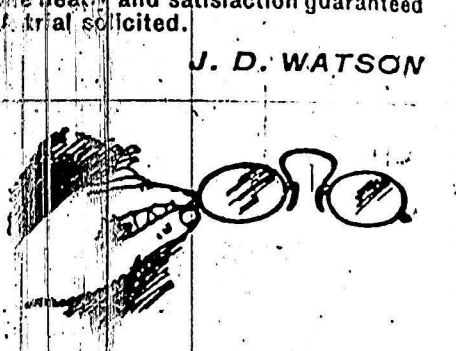
