The former are the outcome of popular uprisings against the tyranny of rulers in other words, of a demand, as (natural right, by the people. Conye. Constitutions are drawn in, uch terms as to lay the greatest stress upon popular rights, while at the same time curtailing the power, of the sovereign. The Japanese Constitution, on the

other; hand, emanated from the Emperor, the fountain head of all pow-Before the people dreamed of popular rights or of a Parliament the Emperor had already marked out the grand policy of establishing consuitutional government in the future, because of his evident desire and purpose to elevate the country to an equal place among the civilized nations of the world, not only because he wished it. but also because that course was in strict accordance with he national policy bequeathed by his ancestors.

Following that policy, our Constiation was drawn up with close adherence to and careful preservation of the fundamental principle of the Imperial Covernment from time immemorial.

In form, however, it is similar to estern Constitutions, with this difrence, that the text of our Constiutions contains only the fundamenrerogatives of the Emperor; ights and duties of the people; the owers of Parliament; the powers ad duties of Ministers of state and These are all embodied in seventy.
