## BANDS OF MERCY.

Juvenile Humane Movement in the Schools.

In various parts of the Province Bands of Mercy have been formed in the public schools and among little groups of children owing to the extensive educational work carried on by the Toronto Humane Society. This is regarded by the promoters of humane work as the beginning of an extensive organization among children for the protection of animals and the development of kindly feelings towards both man and animal.

The mode of procedure in forming a band is very simple. The children are told about the work, and if they wish to join they sign their names to the following pledge:

"I will try to be kind to all harmless living creatures, and try to protect them from cruel usage."

It has been found that the best way to teach the children the principles of the band is to let them see the results of their efforts. For example, the children are shown how to care for animals, how to help them, and how to protect them from harm.

The Juvenile Bands of Mercy are

They then decide upon a name for their band and elect a president, secretary-treasurer and a committee of five.

Meetings are held every fortnight, or as often as the band desires, and the children give recitations, or relate incidents of how they tried to protect animals being abused during the preceding week.

The band's underlying principle is the band of Mercy is to develop kindness and thoughtfulness in children. Besides protecting animals, they may devise schemes for giving pleasure to the poor and the sick.

They will learn to carry flowers to the sick bedside, to collect money by means of small entertainments,

to buy the rent of some poor old woman, or to aid the Children's Aid Society.

In this way selfishness is gradually crowded out, the little one goes about with a bright face and becomes a veritable household sunbeam.

Another need not go upstairs to fetch something because nine feet are waiting to do her bidding.

Father does not call for his slips, because little thought had been given to his chair.

Thus the band of Mercy becomes a blessing to the home and the community, and the cruel collective spirit is suppressed by a feeling of universal brotherhood.

At the meetings the children entertain proceedings by singing a number of hymns, specially adapted for the movement.
