The council of every township, city town and incorporated village may pass by-laws against the sale, by retail, of spirituous, fermented or other manufactured liquors in any favern, inn or any other place or house of public entertainment, and for prohibiting the sale thereof, except by wholesale, in shops and places other than houses of public entertainment.

The right of the Legislature to enact this law has been up-held by the Court

of appeal. A local option prohibitory by-law prevents the issue of liquor licenses. All the machinery and authority of the license law are available under it for the prevention of any liquor selling, except by authorized drug stores. | It means the absolute prohibition of the retail sale, of liquor, not the wholesale. The Act defines the sale of liquor by wholesale as selling, bartering trafficking in liquor in quantities of not less than five gallons each, or in the case of bottled liquor, one dozen bottles of three half-pints. No retail-

ing must be done on any premises, even where there is wholesaling. Sec. 63 prohibits the consumption of liquor on the premises or which it is wholesaled or in any building which communicates with such premises. The local option by-law amounts to pro-
