DOMESTIC RECIPES.

Ginger Cookies.—One cup of molasses, one egg, one-half cup of brown sugar, one-half cup of butter, one teaspoonful of soda, one tablespoon ginger, flour to roll.

Another pretty dish in which sponge cake plays an important role is made as follows: Prepare for a lemon or orange jelly, and while it is cooling hollow out the center of a square sponge cake, leaving the bottom and sides thick enough to hold the jelly.

EARLIEST CROP FOR FEEDING.

Among dairymen who soil instead of pasture their herd, rye is perhaps the best known and most popular of the early crops for this purpose.

The hard working animal should be well fed, but never overfed. The appetite of many animals becomes less when they are overfed.

It is well known that the milk of a cow which is overfed is of a poorer quality than that of a cow which is well fed.
