upon the owner, possessor or harborer of EVERY dog within the said village of Markdale the annual tax of one dollar, and upon the owner, possessor or harborer of every bitch therein the annual tax of two dollars.

3. UPON the payment of such tax of one dollar on dogs, and two dollars on bitches to the Treasurer to the person paying the same, a tag to be provided by the municipality for such purpose.

4. THE TAG so supplied said municipality shall be attached and securely fastened by the owner, possessor of harborer, or someone for them, around the neck of the dog or bitch in respect of which the above named tax has been paid and said tag issued; the tag to be attached in such a manner as be easily observed.

6. EVERY TAG so issued the municipality shall be good only until the 31st day of Decem ber in each year of it's issue, and unlese the said tax for the ensuing year, commencing on the first day of January following shall have been paid on or before the first day of February following; then and in such case the dog, or bitch wearing the previous year's tag shall be deemed and treated as

a dog or bitch without a tag under the provisions of this by-law, and 7 of this By-law.

7. EVERY owner, possessor or harborer of a dog or bitch within said Municipality who allows such, is to say, to be upon any public street or highway in said village, without paying said tax, procuring and fastening a tag upon said dog or bitch, or keeping the same fastened thereon in accordance with the provisions of this By-Law-shall on conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace of the County of Grey, be liable to a fine not exceeding the sum of ten dollars and costs, and in default of payment thereof, and in the event of no dis. period not exceeding twenty-one


