IS A PROVINCIAL MATTER

Toronto, April 23.-The Hydro-Electric power legislation passed by the Ontario Legislature, for which disallowance was asked by certain financial interests in Toronto and Montreal, is not ultra vires of the Legislature, and the petition for disallow-ance is refused.
