London Near Horseless Age.

Last Equine Hauled Omnibus will be Discarded this month.

London, Nov. 17.—The London General Omnibus Company has announced an impending event that marks an epoch in the history of London. At the end of the present month the last horse omnibus of the company's equipment will be withdrawn from the London streets, and thenceforward the entire fleet will be motor driven.

There remain thirty of the company's horse omnibuses, which carry on the hopeless competition against the conquering petrol on three routes. Of these, twenty which run on the cross routes from Finchley to Chelsea and from Wandsworth by Kensington to Shepherd's Bush will make their last trips on Wednesday evening next, leaving only ten, on the London Bridge and Moorgate street route, to linger until Nov. 18, when their tragedy will come.

After Nov. 30 a few horse omnibuses belonging to smaller proprietors may continue to drag weary wheels along suburban by-roads, but not for long.

English Seek David's Tomb.

Britishers are in Quest of Burial Places in Ancient Zion.

London, Nov. 18.—Under the leadership of Captain Parker, an archaeological expedition has left here for Jerusalem to continue the work of the last two years on the site of the ancient Zion with the view of discovering the burial places of David and Solomon.

Captain Parker, a brother of Earl Morley, was in command of the expedition, in which the Duchess of Marlborough was said to be interested and which got into disfavor recently with the Turkish government and Moslem authorities, who accused the excavators of desecrating the sacred mosque of Omar. The second in command is Clarence Wilson, and the party was completed by the addition of a number of English laborers.

The expedition sailed on Wilson's yacht to Jaffa, whence it will travel to Jerusalem. On arrival there the excavators will resume work in the underground passages on Mount Ophel. This month is now a cabbage garden which supplies Jerusalem with vegetables, but in ancient times it was supposed to be the site of the Biblical Zion.

The work, which will be directed from the head quarters of the expedition at Siloam, will be supervised by Turkish government inspectors, specially selected by the imperial authorities at Constantinople.

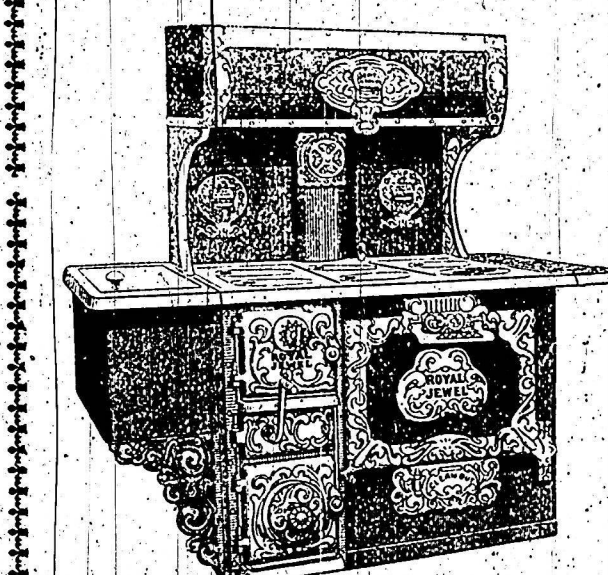
Why Our Young Men Go Out West.
