Boil from 10 to 15 mil utes, according to its age. Drain it and rub it through a sieve and take five tablespoonfuls for t soup. Slice one large onion; boil t in boiling salted water drain it and fry in one heaping tablespoonful of butter to a light brown. Boil one quart of milk with one dozen whole white peppers and add the onion. Simmer it gently for half an hour, strain out the onion and whole peppers and add the propered spinach. Mix all smoothly and boil up, thickening it, if necessary with butter and flour worked to
