





EXECUTION BY DROWNING. It Was Quite a Common Thing the Middle Ages.

This mode of capital punishmen has not long coased in Europe, and is probably still in use in other parts of the world. As early as the first century of our era the Ger mans executed the meaner more infamous triminals by niung ing them in bogs and fens. Middle Ages executing by drownin was so common that grants of th right to inflict capital punishment ran "with pit and gallow." The pi or well was for drowning female de linquents, but the penalty sometimes inflicted on men. doem of the parricide was to be up in a sack and east into the Drowning seems to have been regarded as a mild form of the leat penalty, for in the year 1563 a mai convicted of theft and sacrilege wa sentenced to be sufficited by vater "by the. Queen's special grace." At this date the penalty had growt nearly obsolete in England, but Scotland it survived until 1986. The last execution in Switzerland was in 1652, in Austria 1776, in Toy land 1777, and in Russia carly the eighteenth century. One of the most eccentric modes of inflicting the penalty was adopted in Sexon in the year 1734.
