ARMY OF 300,000 CAVALRY SEMIRAMIS INVADED INDIA WITH THIS FORCE. A Written Record of Horses in Arabia at Least 3,500 Years B.C.

It was the fashion of a few years ago to claim that the Arab horse did not exist, excepting as a figment of the imagination. Scientists later were compelled to acknowledge that there was such a horse, and that he differed from all others even in his anatomy.

INTERNATIONAL LESSON, JUNE 29. Lesson XIII. The Victories of Faith—Review. Golden Text, I John 5:4.
