## HOME

Favorite Recipes

**Black Baked Chicken.**—Take one and one-half pounds of small pork chops. Then make a dressing of one part bread crumbs, one egg, one-half cup of milk, one tablespoon of onion chopped fine, salt, pepper and butter. Between two chops place a thick layer of dressing, tying the two chops together with a string. Put into a baking pan with a little water, cover and bake one and one-half hours, basting frequently. Serve with gravy made from juices.

**Bake Pudding.**—One pound seed of dates, one cup English walnuts, four tablespoons flour, one cup brown sugar, two eggs, well beaten. Butter a bake dish and set that dish into another dish of boiling water and bake twenty-five minutes. When cooling pour over it one cup of sweet cream.

**One Egg Custard.**—Heat two cups milk and four tablespoons stiffed flour and four tablespoons sugar, mixing well together. Add this gradually to the milk, stirring well over low fire. Add the well beaten yolk of an egg with a dash of salt. Still stirring, cook until the mixture is reasonably thick. Out of the white of the egg make a meringue, adding a pinch of baking powder to keep the crust soft and light.

**Custard Corn Bread.**—One quart boiling milk, one scant pint corn meal, Stir meal into milk as for mush, add one teaspoonful of lard or lard, one tablespoonful of sugar. When cool add two well beaten eggs and three teaspoonful of baking powder, one teaspoonful of salt. Bake in the dish in which it is served.

**Robe de Chambre.**—Boil six uniform potatoes. Peel in the oven. When done cut a water for the side of each potato and remove the contents, leaving a firm shell. Beat well and add one table-spoonful of melted butter, salt as wished, and sufficient heated cream to make a stiff. Press through a vegetable sieve. Lightly fill potatoes, make a groove in each potato and drop in an egg. Dress with salt and pepper, and place on a hot fire.
